Asbestos Exposure in the Military

Asbestos was used in the military throughout the 20th century. Asbestos-containing materials were commonly used at military bases, in barracks, at shipyards, aboard ships, on military vehicles and heavy equipment, and in aircraft. Almost 30% of all people who are diagnosed with mesothelioma each year are veterans of the U.S. military. Asbestos exposure is the primary cause of mesothelioma.


ARMY

Soldiers were at risk for exposure to asbestoscontaining materials on base in barracks and during maintenance of motor pool and operational vehicles, as well as during transport via ship.




NAVY & COAST GUARD

Navy service members were at high risk for exposure to asbestoscontaining materials at shipyards and aboard ship, including in engine rooms, boiler rooms, and other engineering spaces.



MARINES

In the Marines, soldiers may have encountered asbestos-containing materials in housing units, on ships, and in land bases.



AIR FORCE

Airmen were at risk for exposure to asbestoscontaining materials associated with aircraft, including products used in high heat applications and aircraft brakes.
